DOG BARKING COMPLAINTS

If we receive a barking dog complaint and are able to confirm that it meets the "loud and habitual" criteria, these would be the steps:

DISCUSSION

- 1. Someone from the board tries to call or stop by to discuss the issue with the homeowner,
- 2. If #1 does not resolve the issue, we inform Ada Township and they send a 1st notice,
- 3. If #2 does not resolve the issue, we inform Ada Township and they send a 2nd notice.
- 4. If #3 does not resolve the issue, we Ada Township and they send a Final Notice.
